It is an elegant choice for luxurious beach accommodation on Zanzibar. Located on the East Coast with all mod-cons and entertainment to hand, Breezes Beach Club is the best of Zanzibar's larger hotels.

The accommodation at Breezes Beach Club is in spacious and comfortable stone flats, with air-conditioning and a choice of standard, Deluxe or Suite, depending on whether rooms are at ground level with balconies or on the second floor with extensive bougainvillea trailed verandas.

A small restaurant on stilts above the beach also caters to those of a more romantic inclination - for a few who might wish to pay a little extra and enjoy a more extravagant a la carte menu than those in the large central restaurant - although the latter is well designed to diminish the impression of its size, and meals here are sumptuous and imaginative.

The beach is refreshingly wild and endless, with fantastically soft coral sand in thick drifts and shaded by coconut palms. With other facilities such as a great pool, a respected dive centre, tennis courts and a fantastic, Frangipani Spa, the hotel offers something for everyone.
