

Kleins Camp Serengeti

Situated high on the Kuka Hills in a private concession, just beyond the boundaries of the Serengeti, Kleins Camp commands visionary views over the Serengeti and the plains extending up to Kenya.

A further joy of this excellent location is that Kleins is not bound by the rules of the Serengeti, so the few guests in camp at any one time can enjoy night drives and safaris in open-sided vehicles, and walk in the surrounding bush. A tradition encourages all guests to climb the small hill behind the camp each evening, and enjoy immaculately prepared sun-downers at the top, although the views from the central dining and bar area are equally impressive.

The entirety of Kleins Camp is constructed and decorated with solid, good-quality furnishings and inspires a great sense of peace and comfort, enhanced by the knowledge that this is such a great distance from any other sign of civilization.

Accommodation is in eight cosy round cottages built from local stone and thatch, each with richly polished wooden floors and decorated in a classic style with pale nets and linens. There is a small pool for a post-safari dip.

One key fact about Kleins Camp is that it is located just outside of the Serengeti in an area known as Loliondo, which essentially means that activities such as night drives and walking safaris are possible.
