

## Zanzibar Palace Stone Town

This is a relatively new addition to Stone Town situated in the Kiponda region; close to the port, the House of Wonders and Mercury's (a good place to watch the sun go down). It is a small boutique hotel with excellent rooms. Especially the Suites which are beautiful...one has a rooftop bathroom and sundeck! They offer a highly personalized service and will help you with all aspects of your stay (organising tours etc.)

There is a lovely homely feel to this place as it is run by a Belgian couple Sebastiaan and Marion who have developed the establishment with all mod cons (board games, plasma TV, dvd vault) while still ensuring it retains all the charm of a traditional Stone Town accommodation.

Just like its neighbour 236 Hurumzi (once known as the Emerson & Green) each of the 9 rooms has its own and very unique style like, the Zanzibar has simply modernized this concept bringing it to the next level. Whether you chose the Nadia room or the Suite Dunia you can be guaranteed a quality in style and finish.
