

Ngorongoro Serena Ngorongoro

This lodge provides an impressive rocky bastion against the cool highland mists. With spacious and cosy rooms, featuring full sliding-glass panels between bed and the open jaws of the Ngorongoro Conservation area are stunning.

The 75 rooms of the Lodge are laid out on two levels in long lines along the crater rim, making it feel much bigger than the other Tanzanian Serena properties. The whole hotel is well decorated with hand-painted cave-type illustrations and styling throughout.

The dining room and bar are warm and inviting, with crackling wood fires in each, and the menu is regularly updated to incorporate local produce that is in season during your stay. One of three lodges around the crater rim, the hotel really benefits from being located close to one of the two access roads.

On the whole, as can be gathered from the above, the hotel has been designed with viewing the Crater in mind. From the moment you wake until the time you retire, the views are spectacular!
